## *Movies*

- **Captain America: The First Avenger (2011)** – Steve Rogers, a young man trying to join the military during WWII, is made into a scientifically enhanced super-soldier and finds himself face-to-face with the Nazi menace.
  - Rated PG-13
- **Chariots of Fire (1981)** – Two Olympic track athletes, one a Jew and one a Christian, find their faith challenged as obstacles are put in their way.
  - Rated PG
- **Les Miserables (2012)** – Jean Valjean, a convicted criminal, tries to rebuild his life, but is haunted by his past in this Musical portrayal of a novel by Victor Hugo.
  - Rated PG-13
- **The Passion of the Christ (2004)** – Director Mel Gibson retells the Gospel story of Christ’s passion and death in a moving and remarkably accurate portrayal.
  - PLEASE NOTE: This film is rated R for scenes of graphic violence.
- **Paul, Apostle of Christ (2018)** – Pulling from the Acts of the Apostles and Paul’s letters to recreate the Saint’s last few months on earth, this film is compelling and insightful into the life of the early Church.
  - Rated PG-13
- **A Quiet Place (2018)** – As predatory monsters destroy the world around them, a family struggle to survive and support each other. The parents, Evelyn and Lee portray a self-sacrificial and devoted parenthood.
  - Rated PG-13
- **The Sound of Music (1965)** - A young woman named Maria leaves an Austrian convent to care for a wealthy war hero’s children at a time when Nazi Germany is extending its influence.
  - Rated G

- **Unplanned (2019)** – Based on the protagonist’s memoirs, this movie portrays Abby Johnson’s radical shift from Planned Parenthood clinic director to ardent Pro-Life activist.
  - PLEASE NOTE: This film is rated R for some disturbing/bloody images.
- **It’s a Wonderful Life (1946)** – A desperate businessman feels that his life is worthless, but an angel attempts to show him otherwise.
